László Bak (HU) before obtaining his law degree in 2004 from the Catholic University Péter Pázmány, László spent a two-year internship at an international law firm. After graduation, he became legal trainee for four years at a small-sized law firm dealing with civil law cases and litigation matters. In 2009, László obtained a Master of Laws (LL.M.) in German law at the Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität in Munich. In the same year, he passed his bar exam, was admitted to the Budapest Bar and subsequently worked as a self-employed lawyer.

He joined the *Gazdasági Versenyhivatal* in November 2010 and became chief of staff. He participated as speaker at seminars organised by the OECD-GVH Regional Centre for Competition in Budapest dealing with illicit information exchange and evidence and proof in cartel cases. He is author of a study dealing with human rights and competition law and co-author of a study on the overlaps of competition law and public procurement. As of February 2014, László was appointed as head of the litigation section. He is fluent in English and German.
