## Attila Dudra member of the Competition Council Hungarian Competition Authority

Attila Dudra graduated as an economist from the University of Miskolc at the Faculty of Economics in 2000, and later, in 2004, he gained a law certificate for economists. He joined the Hungarian Competition Authority in 2001, where he has since worked in a number of units in various positions. He started his carrier as an investigator in competition supervision proceedings related to network industries and media markets. In 2011 he was charged with the responsibility of leading the Network Industries Unit. From 2012 he had been the first Head of the Merger Unit until he became the Member of the Competition Council in March 2016. At the Competition Council his portfolio mainly consists of merger cases, but he also deals with abuse of dominant position and consumer protection cases. On behalf of the Hungarian Competition Authority he has been a member of the ECN Merger Working Group from 2012.
